HEVER CASTLE & PENSURST PLACE

Best known as Anne Boleyn's childhood home, **Hever Castle's** history spans 700 years. Its panelled rooms contain fine furniture, tapestries, antiques and portraits and in its award-winning gardens you can admire the giant topiary chess set and over 4000 roses.



In the afternoon we visit **Penshurst Place**, one of England's oldest family-owned estates, in the hands of royalty & nobles since 1341. The medieval Baron's Hall with its original beamed ceiling and unique octagonal hearth, the many staterooms in different styles and the historic gardens with their distinctive 'rooms' considered to be among the most beautiful in England are definitely not to be missed!
