ALTHORP (HH) & CANON'S ASHBY (NT)



Althorp House is the historic and beautiful estate that has been home to the Spencer family for over 500 years and was the home of Princess Diana. It boasts a rich collection of art, books and furnishings. It also has a magnificent landscape park with gardens, woodlands and lakes. The Stables Café serves soup, sandwiches & cake.

Canon's Ashby is an unusual and cosy Elizabethan house with grand rooms, wall paintings & tapestries, servants' quarters, lovely grounds and a priory church to explore. You will want to spend more time here than you think! It has a very good tearoom and a shop.
