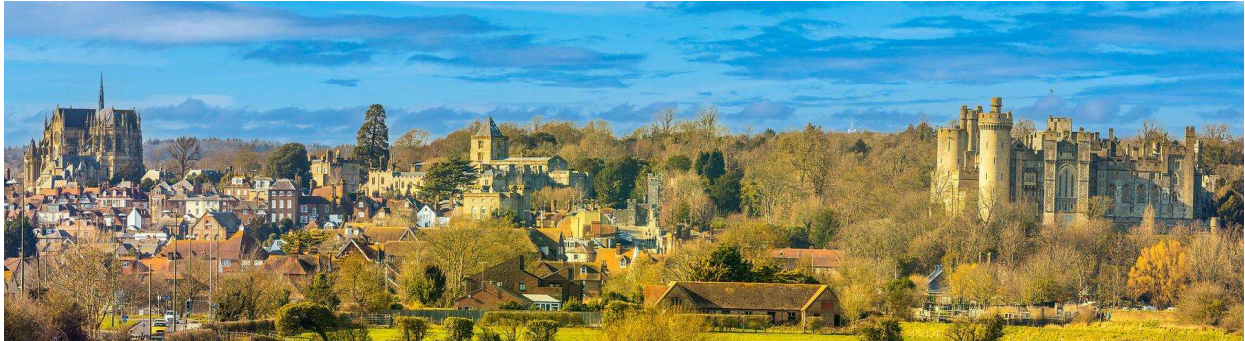

ARUNDEL CASTLE & ARUNDEL TOWN



Arundel Castle commands the landscape with magnificent views across the South Downs and the River Arun. Many of its original features have survived from the end of the 11th century until today. Between **1870 – 1890** the house was almost completely rebuilt in the Victorian gothic style and the finely preserved interior has fascinating furniture, tapestries and rare paintings on show. Discover the family stories of the owners of Arundel, who were at the forefront of English history for 850 years. Your **GOLD PLUS TICKET** gives you access to all areas, including the gardens. We shall have lunch at the castle.
