

GUIDELINES FOR 'ASSOCIATE' MEMBERS ATTENDING AVU3a INTEREST GROUPS

An 'associate' member is a person who is not a fully paid-up member of AVu3a but has membership of another u3a.

AVu3a welcomes associate members to attend our interest groups. There is no fee at the moment. However, there are restrictions in place which every associate member must follow:

- attendance of no more than three interest groups, subject to there being space in the relevant group
- still have to pay for any individual group expenses such as room hire and/or refreshments
- show proof of belonging to the u3a where full membership is paid (number, email, card) to the leaders of the relevant groups when he/she attends for the first time;
 leaders will keep a record (membership number and expiry date)
- cannot attend Monthly, AGM and EGM meetings
- pay full price to attend subsidised events e.g. summer BBQ
