and the LONDON BOROUGH MARKET

Crossness has long been a firm favourite with tour groups. Built in 1865 by Sir Joseph Bazalgette as part of Victorian London's sewerage system, it is a masterpiece of 19th Century engineering and architecture.

The visit includes :-

- An illustrated talk – giving historical context and build up to the Great Stink of 1858, which hindered the work of Parliament.
- A guided tour
- Free time to explore the Great Stink exhibition and the wonderful collection of toilets!
