## **SALISBURY CATHEDRAL & WILTON HOUSE**

Salisbury is home to one of our most iconic cathedrals and there is much to see there. Amongst other things it houses one of only four surviving copies of Magna Carta, the world's oldest working mechanical clock and a beautiful and unique modern font. Apart from visiting the Cathedral itself, you can take a delightful walk around the cathedral close (Britain's largest), where there are many impressive houses to see. You can picnic here or lunch in the cathedral's excellent refectory.

### **Salisbury Cathedral Visitor Guide**

In the afternoon you visit Wilton House, home to the Earls of Pembroke since the 1540s. The house is set in 22 acres of parkland and gardens and houses a world famous art collection.
