## THE VYNE (NT) & HENLEY- ON –THAMES

**The Vyne** is a beautiful Tudor house built for Henry VIII's Lord Chamberlain. It was restyled in 17<sup>th</sup> century into a family home. It houses a superb Tudor chapel and one of the earliest long galleries in the country. It sits in 1,500 acres of gardens and woodlands and in autumn you can stroll beneath a copper canopy. Lunch will be taken at their café.
